The track worthiness of your car is your responsibility. Please inspect, or have inspected these important aspects of your car. Print and complete the form, and don't forget to bring it with you to the check-in station at the track. Also have your safety gear available for inspection.

Cars must be presented in a neat and finished condition. Engine compartment, suspension, chassis and drive line must be clean enough to facilitate inspection. Cables and wires should be secured to prevent chafing, etc.

WHEELS & TIRES

- o All 4 tires above the tread wear marker
o Tires inflated to recommended pressure
o All lug nuts present and tight per spec
o Hubcaps, trimmings removed

STEERING & SUSPENSION

- o Wheel bearings: no play
o Minimum steering play

ENGINE

- o No fluid leaks
o Catch container on radiator overflow - CAS/HOD reserves the right to inspect any car suspected of violation or appears to be unsafe.
o Hoses & belts in good condition
o Positive battery terminal covered
o Oil level full
o Radiator full - Use of water rather than coolant is recommended. Water wetter products are allowed.

BRAKES

- o Over 1/2" thickness - pads or shoes
o Rotors - no cracks or high spots
o Solid pedal feel
o Crack-free brake lines
o Brake lights work (at least 1 working brake light)

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- o SEAT BELTS: Properly functioning factory belts required.
o Functional head rest
o ROLL BARS: Pop-up rollover systems are not allowed. Hoop systems (i.e., Boxster, S2000, Audi TT, 350Z, Z4, Z8, 2007 and newer models of the Miata MX-5, and similar) may be allowed on a case by case basis.
o Mirrors: At least 1 rear view mirror is required
o Helmet - Snell SA2000 or newer required. NO motorcycle helmets allowed.

- o Long-sleeve cotton shirt
o Long pants - NO synthetic material
o Close-toed shoes
o Fire-resistant or Leather gloves
o Proper face protection - Goggles or a protective face shield must be worn in open cars. Non-breakable glasses or face shield are strongly recommended in closed cars.

MISCELLANEOUS

- o Gas cap secured
o No exposed electrical wires
o No exhaust leaks
o No loose objects in car or trunk
o Battery bolted down with 2 bolts
o CAR RACE NUMBERS: All event numbers will be approved. Numbers should be 2" in width and 12" in height and clearly visible
o TOW HOOKS: It is recommended that all cars have an eyebolt or equivalent to attach a tow cable.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-STREET CARS

- o THROTTLE RETURN SPRINGS: For non-street cars each carburetor must have it's own throttle return spring in addition to the overall system linkage spring. Springs on body of carburetor do not count as external return springs. Fuel injection systems must have a backup return spring in addition to the overall system spring.
o FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: All non-street cars must be equipped with a 2 lb., 10 BC (or Halon equivalent) fire extinguisher securely mounted with a metal bracket and metal strap, plastic is not acceptable.
o ELECTRICAL CUT-OFF SWITCH: It is recommended that each non-street car have a master electrical cut-off switch fitted outside the car and be clearly marked.
